Reference is made to your letter dated September 22, 1964, your reference No. 5955.

Enclosed is one copy each of three letters dated November 25 and 29, 1963, and September 27, 1963, which we have received from the subject and which follow the same pattern as the copy of the letter you sent us. For your information, we have conducted no investigation of the subject.

We have no objection to your asking the appropriate authorities in Malaysia to let you know if Webster should come to notice in that part of the world.

NOTE:

Classified "Secret" because inquiry from Phillipotts regarding this subject was so classified. Incoming advised that subject, who lives in the Far East, has developed his theories about the assassination of President Kennedy to the point of absurdity. Subject wrote British Embassy, Washington, D.C., from Malaysia setting forth these theories. British are interested in him since there are similarities in the personal histories of Webster and an individual who visited the British Embassy in Moscow on July 29, 1964, to tell the story about his meetings with Lee Harvey Oswald in the USSR in 1960. British requested any background information on subject and proposed asking appropriate authorities in Malaysia about Webster. The enclosures received by us from Webster generally follow the same pattern as the letter received by the British.
