Dear Mr. Marwell:

By letter dated March 3, 1995, I provided comments on behalf of the FBI regarding the Assassination Records Review Board's (the Board) proposed regulation containing guidance on the interpretation of the term "assassination record" and "additional information and records" included in the "President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992" (the Act). Inspector Terry T. O'Connor discussed those FBI comments at the Board's public meeting in Washington, D.C., on Tuesday, March 7, 1995. This letter sets forth additional comment suggested by Mr. O'Connor's dialogue with the Board and other discussion at the meeting last Tuesday.

During the public meeting, the Board, through Mr. O'Connor, invited the FBI's attention to language in Subsection (a) of Section 1400.1 of the proposed regulation. That Section provides assistance in the interpretation of the term "assassination record." The specific language discussed was that involving records relating to "activities and events that may have led to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy." As Mr. O'Connor told the Board, the FBI had no concern with this language at the time of my March 3 letter and believes that the Board would provide a reasonable basis for requesting records covered by this terminology.
