While I am governed by our Access to Information (ATI) and Privacy Acts (PA) with respect to what information is releasable under these statutes, I have released all contained personal information innocuous Personal information such as the name, address, birth date, etc. of an individual who has not been, or has not been proven to be deceased for at least twenty years, must be protected. Although some of this information may be considered dated, it still constitutes personal/ identifiable information pertaining to the individual it relates to. Release of this information is not in the public interest and would be of benefit to no one. have highlighted those portions in pink and request that this information continue to be protected from release under subsection 6(3) of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992. 105-103 Information obtained from the Alberta Government
