Synopsis: Results of San Antonio indices search set forth and one responsive document enclosed.

Details: San Antonio has completed indices searches for any additional information related to President John F. Kennedy's assassination. These searches were negative for any information in San Antonio files pertaining to all of the names listed in the reference communication with the exception of Lee Harvey Oswald.

Two references to the name Lee Harvey Oswald were located. SA 62-0-19184 is missing and it appears that this document, which was indexed on 05/21/1987, has been destroyed during routine file destruction procedures. The other reference, SA 89-0-314, enclosed, is an airtel from Houston to Dallas, 05/14/1992, captioned "Lee Harvey Oswald, aka; Assassination of John F. Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas; AFO."

San Antonio also conducted a search of all SAC material stored in this office without locating any documents pertaining to the President Kennedy assassination.

Due to the unavailability of the IIS Analyst, deadline of 06/12/1998 was missed. On 06/09/1998 Carol Keeley was advised that this deadline would be missed and she stated that it would be sufficient to respond as soon as possible after the IIS Analyst returned.
