On 12-7-59, DL-6-8, who has furnished reliable information in the past, made available to SA, W. MARLAN BROWN a hand-written report dated 12-1-59, concerning a contact between JOE LANDIN and AUGUSTIN ESTRADA on 12-1-59. The original report is filed as 134-1A-491.

On this occasion, LANDIN asked ESTRADA if he had read the Dallas news article entitled "Four youth Gangs Turning Dallas Into Battle Field." ESTRADA is supposed to have replied that he had not heard of the article, but commented that it could do more harm than good, as it dealt with Latin American juvenile delinquents. ESTRADA commented that he wanted to go to JOE's home that night and discuss the matter if he could.

Informant understood that during the discussion, the matter of LANDIN's news letter came up, and LANDIN stated that he wanted to let the people know that the Hall of State's derogatory exhibit at the State Fair of Texas concerning "Dead Mexicans" had been taken off. LANDIN supposedly said that he had been reluctant to print this information because BILL LOWERY had indicated at a forum meeting that they should keep it quiet as the item had been taken off. ESTRADA commented that he saw no harm in printing such information, especially if the forum people had discussed it. They were waiting for the results. LANDIN reportedly said that he would print the news letter for the next GI Forum meeting which was to be held on 12-8-59.
