On 7/8/60, a handwritten report was received by SA W. HARLAN BROWN from DL-6-S in person, dated 7/6/60, which has been serialized as 134-1A-525. (JFK)

That report stated that a regular meeting of the CP was held at AUGUSTIN ESTRADA's home, and present were AUGUSTIN, BILL LOWERY, RUTH LOWERY and MARGARET LANDIN. RUTH LOWERY and MARGARET LANDIN visited with MRS. ESTRADA while the men had a meeting.

At this meeting, according to informant's report, BILL LOWERY brought up the letter he had received from DR. GARCIA. AUGUSTIN ESTRADA said he knew a little about it, since JOE LANDIN had visited him on Tuesday, July 5. BILL LOWERY stated that at a G.I. Forum meeting, a member, JOE MOLINA, seemed reluctant to do anything about GARCIA's suggestions. In fact, MOLINA seemed as if he wanted to discourage the other members from doing anything. LOWERY added that he fought all the way to do something constructive, and as a result, a committee volunteered to discuss the letter further and perhaps form a VICENTE TREVINO MEMORIAL COMMITTEE. BILL LOWERY stated MOLINA was one of those who volunteered to form the committee, and that MOLINA seemingly became unpopular at the meeting because of the reactionary attitude that he took. BILL LOWERY said there were six new members at this meeting, but the majority of them did not take an active part. To speed up things, BILL LOWERY said he would call an emergency meeting early next week to follow through on the Trevino case. He asked JOE LANDIN to print 200 copies of the letter that GARCIA had written to him. Each of the eleven Latin-American clubs would get one, and it could be that these letters would be distributed from house to house.
