On 5/3/61, DL-6-S, in person, furnished a typewritten report to SA W. HARLAN BROWN, which report is dated 5/3/61, and has been serialized as 134-1A-588.

Informant in this report stated he learned that JOE LANDIN is planning to publish a newspaper once a month to be known as "The Dallasites' Journal." He will discuss the paper with AUGUSTIN ESTRADA and they will determine what will go in the newspaper.

According to informant, some of the newspaper articles that JOE LANDIN has saved deal with the battle of the Alamo, the battle of San Jacinto, racial discrimination, the winners of the Congressional Medal of Honor, the death penalty, the Panama Canal, Nazis in West Germany, Amerigo Vespucci, the GI Forum, definitions by HENRY STEELE COMMAGER, Senator JIM EASTLAND and many other subjects. The newspaper is scheduled to be out the second Sunday in May.

Informant had no additional information.
