On 4/25/63, DL-6-S, in person, furnished to SA W. HARLAN BROWN a handwritten report dated 4/10/63, which report has been serialized as 134-1A-746.

That report revealed that on 4/10/63, JOE LANDIN attended a GI Forum meeting. The meeting, held at ALBERT CROYCOS' home, was a reorganization meeting. The American GI Forum Dallas Chapter had not held any meetings regularly for quite sometime. Nine persons attended this meeting. The dues which were \$5.00 per annum are now \$2.50, informant said. The chapter pays the other half. The dues' reduction, it is hoped, will encourage more people to join. The initiation fee remains 50¢. The chapter will have a stand at Pikes Park during the Cinco de Mayo Mexican Independence Day.

Informant determined that at this meeting, Crystal City was briefly discussed. Most of the members had vaguely heard of that city's elections (City Council and School Board elections).

Informant had no additional information.
