DL-6-S on 12/16/64 furnished to SA EDWIN D. KUYKENDALL a handwritten report dated 12/14/64. It is filed as 134-1A-875.

Informant advised ALBERT OROZCO, GI Forum member, Dallas, called JOE LANDIN, Dallas, to invite him to a GI Forum meeting. In their conversation, OROZCO told LANDIN he was planning to talk to the Chief of Police, Dallas, to clear the GI Forum's name. The Dallas COP had on television indicated that the GI Forum and PASO were subversive organizations. This happened shortly after President KENNEDY's assassination. Off and on OROZCO meets potential Forum members who decline to join that organization because of the above mentioned bad publicity.

Informant stated JOE MOLINA, a past member of GI Forum, was questioned by the Dallas PD on the night President KENNEDY was killed. MOLINA was described as a subversive, by the Dallas Times Herald Television station, and MOLINA has sued the newspaper. OROZCO told LANDIN, FORUM's high officials had not come to MOLINA's aid. OROZCO had spoken to BILL LOWERY and had been told that LOWERY had not given MOLINA's name to the FBI. OROZCO said this apparently was true. Since the FBI has told MOLINA that they had not given MOLINA's name to the police, it was not known where the police obtained MOLINA's name. OROZCO recalled that President KENNEDY was a great friend of the GI Forum.

Informant had no additional information.
