2:21 pm (S) [WF 279-S] (S) 105-24 [Dutyman at Embassy] (S) to unk male, asking for [B.G. KOLODYAZHNY] (S). He was told [KOLOD] was not there. [Dutyman said if KOLOD] came there, to advise him he should be [at the Embassy] (S) at 5:00 pm. OK. (Russian) (S) pwm

2:30 PM (S) [WF 279-S] (S) 105-24 [V.N. ZHEREBTSOV, NY] to I.D. BUBNOV (See p 33856, X & Y), advising [BUBNOV] he would leave New York on the ~~XXXX~~ Congressional train at 4:30 pm tomorrow, arriving in Washington, D.C. at 8:05 pm. [BUB] said he would meet [ZHEREBTSOV] (S) (Russian) (S) pwm
