- 9:43 am [WF 279-S] (S) GORDON MC LENDON (ph) to [G.M. SOKOLOV] (S) stating that he would like to come for a talk [at] the embassy with SOK. SOK (S) said that he would be glad to see MC but that right now would not be convenient. MC suggested that he will be back in town next Thursday and that maybe they could get together then. [SOK] (S) said that this would be fine at 4:00 pm. OK bwr
- 9:25 am [WF 279-S] (S) PAUL KELLY speaks with [A.N. IZVEKOV] (S). IZ. (S) says that they are ready to buy the new Mercury station wagon (Commuter). They want the 6 cylinder with automatic transmission and power (B & S), push button radio and electric clock. They want beige or ivory color. (No heater?) jfb
- 9:28 am [WF 279-S] (S) D.Y. STAROVOITOV (by voice only) (S) speaking with a Mr. SHEITDEMAN (S) (ph), arranging for lunch today at Jenny's. 5.28 [1745 F St. Nat] at 12:15 pm. jfb
- 9:51 am [WF 279-S] (S) I.I. SNOLIN to V.S. MEDVEDEV at Sovdelnyc. MED. (S) is not in. 5.30 Have him call. OK. [Russian] (S) jfb

- 10:00 am [WF 1259-S] (S) G.M. SHAPKIN to DEXTER ANDERSON, State, advising that the I.M. KOLODNIKOV family and L.L. BATOVRINA (and son) (S) will be leaving tomorrow for [the S.U.] (S) via train. They will embark the same day, and leave that evening by boat. 5.33 [Russian] (S) jfb
- 10:07 am [WF 807-S] (S) M.R. SAGATELYNA (S) TO PIERRE SALINGER asking if there will be any announcement [after] the National Security Council Meeting (S). He also asked if [SECY DEAN RUSK] (S) was going to speak. SAL. said that he probably would, but that there would not be any release following this meeting. bwr
- 10:10 am [WF 279-S] (S) P.I. MARKOV (S) to NORMAN COMISKEY, Secy to CYRUS EATON asking COM if there are any food prohibitions as related to MR. EATON. COM pointed out that EATON is a light eater; that he drinks little --- no coffee, some tea or hot water, sherry or a little scotch, and in general he eats what is placed before him (oh for the opportunity.....) (S) COM then asked if [MARKOV] (S) is the assistant to [A.E. SOBRYNIN] (S). Yes. He asked if [SOKOLOV] (S) is no longer with the [ambassador]. MARKOV (S) said that [SOK] (S) is the [Press] (S) assistant. [COM] (S) said that he would no doubt be talking with [MARKOV] (S) again and is very anxious to meet him. jfb
