Attendance at Department of Agriculture Graduate School and George Washington University verified. Employed at NRA from 10/50 to the present--supervisors and associates recommend favorably. Former associates at the Office of Government Reports regard appointee as loyal American. Navy service verified--nothing unfavorable. Neighborhood investigations reflected nothing unfavorable regarding loyalty. Files of Security Division of Department of Commerce contain no additional pertinent information. Files of Investigations Division, CSC, contain nothing unfavorable regarding appointee. Nothing derogatory regarding appointee in files of Washington, D. C., Credit Bureau, and no record of him in files of ONI, MPD-DC, or HCUA. Washington Confidential Informants had no knowledge of appointee.			ADD. DISSEMINATION.
