On November 29, 1963, we received the following information from a source whose reliability has not yet been established:

The subject, a pilot who has been suspected of smuggling various types of merchandise from the United States into Mexico and other South American countries, and who was an associate of Victor Stadter, who reportedly is serving a sentence after being convicted of smuggling narcotics into the United States, inquired of source if he was an airplane pilot. Source advised subject that he was not a pilot; nevertheless, subject stated there were fifty-three aircraft, believed to be light bombers, in Nicaragua and that twenty-six pilots were needed to fly the planes to Cuba making a minimum of two round trips per week. The pilots reportedly would be paid \$1000 per trip. The subject did not divulge the purpose of the proposed flights. Subject then reportedly told the source that he could get source a good paying job if the source had the necessary "guts" to do the job. He stated that the job would pay \$2500 per week which would be deposited in any bank designated by the source and, in addition, would provide a paid up life insurance policy in the amount of \$20,000.

When the source expressed some interest in this proposition the subject stated it would entail going to Cuba, where upon his arrival he would "be on his own" and could expect no help from anyone.

Subject also told the source that a man known only as Edwards of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, was badly wanted by Castro and that the subject had an appointment to meet Edwards in Belize, British Honduras, a few days ago. Edwards and another man flew a rented Beechcraft airplane to the island of Cozumel, off the coast of the Yucatan Peninsula, where they spent the night. They disappeared the following morning and have not been heard

from again. He stated that the owners of the airplane are now trying to collect \$65,000 in insurance for the aircraft. The subject stated he believed Edwards was kidnaped by Castro agents and taken to Cuba for execution. The source did not know where the afore-mentioned airplane had been rented but believed it had come from Fort Lauderdale. With reference to the information in this paragraph, it is possible that Edwards may be Alexander Irwin Rorke, a free-lance newspaperman who claimed to have bombed Havana, Cuba, on April 25, 1963, with others. It is noted that Rorke and Geoffrey Sullivan, an associate, departed the United States on September 24, 1963, after filing flight plans for Honduras. They landed at Cozumel the same afternoon, took off less than two hours later and have not been heard from since.

The source advised that the subject normally resides in Belize, British Honduras, although he makes frequent trips to Donna, Texas, where his father, whose name is also Floyd Park, resides. The source furnished the following description of the subject:
