SUBJECT: Edward F. Weinheimer - Perjury

It is known that Joseph J. ~~Marak~~ was employed as a salesman for Exhibitor's Service Co., Inc., during the period of Edward Weinheimer's tenure with that firm. Marak is still employed there.

In connection with the preparation of the captioned case for trial, it is requested that Marak be interviewed with regard to the following:

1. Any background or pertinent information that Marak can furnish regarding Weinheimer.
2. Any information Marak may possess as to Weinheimer's receipt of cash from Exhibitor's Service Co., Inc., during August and September, 1957.
3. Any conversation Marak may have had with Weinheimer concerning Weinheimer's activities and reasons for visiting Des Moines and Detroit in August and September, 1957.
4. Any information Marak may have obtained concerning Weinheimer's negotiations with labor officials on behalf of Exhibitor's Service Co., Inc.
