On December 28, 1959, H. Clifford Alder, a Washington, D.C. attorney who is representing the above named defendant, advised departmental attorneys that his co-counsel, Kenneth D. Wood, is scheduled to appear in another case on January 11, 1960. Alder advises that since there had been several continuances granted in the other case, he would request a continuance in the Weinheimer case.

Alder recontacted departmental attorneys in the afternoon of December 28, 1959, and stated that District Judge Curran had granted a continuance until February 1, 1960.

On December 29, 1959, we ascertained from the Assignment Commissioner in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia that the Weinheimer case has been set down for trial on February 1, 1960.
