We are in receipt of a photostatic copy of a letter dated February 13, 1960, addressed to Honorable James W. Morris, United States District Court Judge, from George W. Hendrickson, #36476, New Jersey State Prison Farms, Lock Bag K, Rahway, New Jersey. According to this letter, Hendrickson requested that he be interviewed by a member of the Senate Rackets Committee as he claims that he "can be of grave importance to one of today's top problems."
