MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING
(ACCOUNTING AND FRAUD SECTION)

The following uncorroborated information has been received by this Bureau from an individual whose reliability cannot be evaluated at this time. This person has asked that this information be treated with extreme discretion since he fears his life would be in jeopardy should he ever be identified as the source.

According to the informant, on the afternoon of September 8, 1961, Frank J. Matula, Jr., an International Trustee of the Teamsters Union, allegedly had in his possession in Los Angeles, California, an undisclosed amount of cash which Matula was to deliver to Koffa that evening. The informant claimed to have no information as to when, from whom, or the circumstances under which Matula obtained this money.

An investigation of Matula is being undertaken and copies of all reports will be forwarded to the Criminal Division.
