EPSTEIN then advised BRODKIN that HENRY FRIEDENBERG is going to pick him up and that they were going to call on some accounts which HENRY has for EPSTEIN. It is noted that FRIEDENBERG is the subject of a ITWP case in the Chicago Office, and that he is the owner of Acacia Press, the printers of lottery tickets.

At this point, BRODKIN's secretary advised him that she could not reach SMITH at the number left.

FRIEDENBERG arrived in the office at this point and advised BRODKIN and EPSTEIN that they would conduct their business on that date, but that they would also of necessity have to visit BILL KAPLAN in the hospital. FRIEDENBERG indicated that KAPLAN is getting better, but continues to be bedridden. It is noted that KAPLAN is identical with former CG 6272-C, and is the subject of an investigation in this office entitled "ANGEL-KAPLAN SPORTS NEWS SERVICE," CGfile 165-1.

Contact with the sister of KAPLAN determined that KAPLAN has been confined to the hospital and to a rest home since May 4, 1964, and has suffered his third and fourth heart attacks innthe past five months. It is noted that the Assistant U.S. Attorney handling the proposed prosecution of KAPLAN intends to call before the JFK Law 10(a)2 Federal grand jury in the very near future. At the present time KAPLAN is confined in Room 417 at Columbus Hospital.

LEON KESSLER, an associate attorney in the office of Bieber & Brodkin, then conferred with BRODKIN concerning the fact that his neighbor, one HOWARD WEINER (ph), who is a neighbor of KESSLER in Deerfield, Illinois, "got mixed up in an interstate theft case and is presently confined awaiting bond." BRODKIN then made a telephone call to Chicago bondsman EDDIE MORRIS and instructed MORRIS to go over to the Commissioner's office and make bond for WEINER. BRODKIN indicated that "We want
