Previous information was that ALLEY was only a student of architecture while in Denmark. Likewise, MARVIN KANTOR, an acquaintance of ALLEY whom he apparently introduced to VLADISLAV M ABARCHALIN, should be identified. If KANTOR is unknown to the Bureau, Chicago will set forth appropriate leads to obtain background information. It is believed that a more detailed explanation of the manner in which ABARCHALIN initiated contact with ALLEY is necessary. Referenced letter is not clear as to whether their first meeting was arranged merely as a social engagement or involved ABARCHALIN and his "two wives." 来It is also noted that the initial contact between ABARCHALIN and subject, according to information furnished by REU- 31.

Chicago files contain no information identifiable with MARVIN KANTOR or WILLIAM VALENCIA.

If the Bureau does not deem it appropriate at this time to request a further clarification from CIA of the information referred to, such action can be deferred until receipt of information from Legat, London who, by Chicago letter 8/29/60, was requested to recontact E. MOGENS JENSEN Chief, Danish Security Service. Because of the likelihood that Legat, London has already contacted MOGGENS JENSEN, no additional request is being made of the Legat, London until a comparison can be made between information from that source and CIA information. The Bureau may wish to furnish Legat, London a copy of referenced letter if this has not already been done.

By separate communication a lead is being set forth for St. Louis to attempt to locate the Army Service record of the subject.

Also, FD 227 is being forwarded to the Bureau to request a mail cover on subject's residence.
