RE: Chicago letter dated August 29, 1960, requesting original source, [which was the Danish Security Service], be re-contacted for further information regarding subject. (S) (P)

There are enclosed the original and five copies of a memorandum [setting forth in detail all information available to the Danish Security Service. This information was classified "confidential" and was received on November 21, 1960, from Mr. E. MOGENS JENSEN, Chief of the Danish Security Service. (S) (P) Contained in the enclosure is information regarding MARVIN KANTOR, who is the subject of Bufile 105-77772. There is also information on [MORRAY BROWN] subject of Bufile [105-83198]. (S) (P)

Mr. JENSEN asked that the information not be used by the Bureau in any way which would indicate to any other agency that the information came from the Danish Security Service. He also requested that any additional information developed by the Bureau concerning ALLEY's contact with ABARCHALINE of the Soviet Embassy in Copenhagen be furnished to him because of their continued interest in ABARCHALINE's intelligence activities in Denmark. (S) (P)

From the information contained in the enclosure it would appear that these meetings were certainly clandestine in nature and also that books and periodicals were passed between the two. It should also be noted that, according to the Danes, subject left Denmark on February 13, 1960. (S) (P)

The Danish Security Service is being carried as T-1 in the enclosure. (S) (P)
