Dear Mr. Minnich,

Reference is made to your note no. 110-105-3796 of May 21, 1969, and our previous note no. 8/60 of February 10, 1960, concerning the captioned individual on whom the following information is available (c)

1. Subject was assigned to the Soviet Embassy in Denmark during the period September 5, 1958 - October 24, 1961. He was holder of a service passport no. C. 39506, issued in Moscow on July 7, 1958 (c)

2. While in this country, he was accompanied by his wife Renata Josifovna, born April 11, 1930, service passport no. C. 39507, issued in Moscow on July 7, 1958. (c)

3. The wife referred to in your letter, Tamara Mikhaylovna, born March 11, 1935 in Helsinki, Finland, is unknown to us. (c)

4. ABARCHALINE was assigned to the Embassy in Copenhagen as a doorman, working as a kind of head janitor for the other officials concerned with watch duties, but apparently he also worked as a cadre worker of the KGB Residency in Copenhagen. He maintained close relations with Vladimir Alexandrovich TCHOVRANOV, born February 10, 1926, 2. Secretary of the Embassy, who was identified as a KGB Officer. (c)

5. As reported in our note of February 10, 1960, while in this country ABARCHALINE made obvious efforts to get into contact with young Americans studying in Copenhagen. (c)

He managed to obtain contact with Rembert Caven ABLEY, born October 30, 1932, David Allan BOOTH, born February 16, 1932, Murray BROWN, born March 23, 1934, and Marvin KANTOR, born May 9, 1934, which contacts we reported in our note referred to above. (c)


