Enclosed for the Bureau are the original and 4 copies of a letterhead memorandum setting forth information obtained from this informant on 5/28/63.

Informant advised he had given this information to the CIA source, whose identity is known to the Bureau, and the CIA source had subsequently informed him that he had discussed this matter with "his people". Informant stated that the CIA source was optimistic concerning enclosed proposal but advised the informant to take no action in this matter without first contacting this office.

The informant was advised that this office would neither affirm nor reject his participation in the attempt to bring about DUVALIER's removal. It was pointed out to the informant that any decision on what action to follow in this matter would be his own.

The following information was not put in the letterhead memorandum since it was felt it might tend to compromise this informant.

GRANELLO told the source that he wants him to interest DeJOIE in this matter.

GRANELLO told the informant that his contacts with NOBLE are ANTHONY and JOSEPH STACCI, aka TONY and JOE ROGERS. It should be noted that JOE STACCI is a Bureau fugitive and attempts are presently being made to locate him through the informant. GRANELLO told the informant that TONY and JOE ROGERS are extremely close to NOBLE. J. A.

Concerning the \$500,000.00 requested by NOBLE GRANELLO told the informant that if this matter is successful, he will take \$300,000.00 of this amount from NOBLE and split it with the informant evenly. He stated that of the remaining \$200,000.00 TONY ROGERS will demand \$100,000.00 from NOBLE.

GRANELLO also told the informant that, to protect the \$1,500,000.00, this money could be placed in escrow until DUVALIER has left Haiti.
