Source stated that ROTHMAN received the gambling concession at the Copacabana Night Club in Camaguey and that the casino was opened and put into operation on December 31, 1956. (X) Source stated that ROTHMAN received help and political influence from TONY PEREZ BENITOA, who is married to the daughter of President BATISTA of Cuba. Source advised that PEREZ BENITOA is supposed to have a half interest in the gambling casino and that ROTHMAN is acting as manager. Source stated that ROTHMAN also allegedly has slot machines in various bars and night clubs in other cities in Camaguey Province with Source stated that arrangements for installation of the slot machines were made through the influence of PEREZ BENITOA and ALBERT ARDURA. ARDURA is alleged to be one of the principal backers of stot machines in Cuba and is known to have considerable interests in gambling operation in the Havana area. Source was also contacted with reference to fugitive cases pending in the Havana Office and he advised that he has not received any information concerning any of the individuals wanted by the Bureau with reference to whom he had been previously contacted.
