"Fat The Butch", and SIDNEY ORSECK DiCOSTANZO is presently operating the gambling casino in the Hotel Capri and has admitted having ar interest in that casino. has been named by JOHN HOUSER, Vice-President in Charge of International Operations for Hilton Hotels, Inc., as one Jof the five individuals who have been granted the franchise &to operate the gambling casino in the soon-to-be-completed Hotel Havana Hilton. In the past DiCOSTANZO has been described as operating floating crap games in Yonkers. New York, and ORSECK is described as a New York lawyer.
