WISEMAN on 6/11/58that the telephone number TEmple 2-3116 is listed to Mrs. THELEN F. MC GINTY, 142 Seaspray Avenue, Palm Beach, Florida, Who is the wife of THOMAS MC GINTY.

Miss MARYBETH OWEN, Clerk to the District Manager, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, Miami Beach, M) Florida, advised SA ROBERT E. SUNKEL on 7/21/58 that the telephone number UN 6-2886 was listed in the name of SAM A TUCKER, 1437 Viscaya Drive, Miami Beach. According to her records SAM TUCKER indicated that he was owner of the Beverly Hills Country Club, Covington, Kentucky.

It is noted that in accordance with a letter, dated 6/25/58 from the Legat, Havana, JACK LANSKY, who operates a casino in the Hotel Nacional, advised confidentially on May 19, 1958, that a syndicate composed of SAM TUCKER, MORRIS KLEINMAN, TOW MC GINTY and MOE DALITZ owned the gambling concession in the Hotel Nacional.
