Bureau's attention is directed to Bureau file 87-11084, case entitled, "FRANCIS JOHN NELSON, aka, ITSP" in which by letter dated May 14, 1959, to SA JOHN STOKES, subject accused FBI causing him to be forced out of a business and also of notifying Cuban Police he was in the narcotics business.

Bureau letter dated May 27, 1959, (Bufile 87-11084) advised Miami to tell subject to cease and desist making baseless accusations against the FBI. However, Miami was unable to locate subject at that time.
