RE: JORGE ALONSO-PUJOL

Reference is made to your communication dated
November 10, 1964.

Subject is identical with Jorge Alonso Pujol Bermudez
who was born July 20, 1923, in Cuba. Pujol participated in
the April, 1961, invasion of Cuba as a member of Brigade 2506,
the anti-Castro exile group which invaded Cuba. He together
along with other members of the Brigade was captured. His
father personally paid \$100,000 to the Cuban Government for
subject's release. Pujol was reportedly released from prison
in early April, 1962.

On January 9, 1963, the subject advised that he was
the Director of a radio program the purpose of which was to
help liberate the captured members of the above-mentioned
Brigade. The secondary purpose of the program was to assist
in the unification of the Cuban exiles, particularly in the
Miami, Florida, area. Pujol stated he believed that the
matter of Cuba should be dealt with through the Organization
of American States. In addition, Pujol stated that since
the captured members of the Brigade had been returned to the
United States, the above-mentioned program would be discon-
tinued on January 11, 1963.

It is noted that over 1100 members of the above-
mentioned Brigade were returned to the United States in
December, 1962.

In May, 1963, Pujol advised that his parents were then in Madrid, Spain. He denied at that time that he was in any way connected with Cuban political or revolutionary activities.

The subject was formerly an insurance agent in Cuba and his father, Guillermo Pujol, was Vice President of Cuba from 1948 to 1952 under President Carlos Prío Socarras.
