CG T-4 advised recently that he was approached
several years ago by LEONARD PATRICK who offered him the
proposition of taking over gambling and bookie interest
in a district of Chicago supervised by Chicago hoodlum
GUS ALEX. He said PATRICK told him the individuals who
were running this interest at that time were no longer
good and PATRICK offered his backing against them.
