Cuban Refugees in the Cayman Islands
and in the Bahamas

REC-62

We attach two copies of the personal particulars and a brief note on each of seven refugees who arrived in the Cayman Islands in an open boat on 27th February, 1962 (Enclosure I). The boat was taken back to Cuba.

Also attached (Enclosure II) are two copies of a note containing the personal particulars of six Cubans who arrived in Nassau on 22nd February, 1962. It was stated that Rafael REYES Olivero had been forced by the other five men to take them from Nicaro Bay, Cuba, in his 50-ft. ferry boat the "CATSKILL". On 30th January they were wrecked on an uninhabited cay in the Bahamas and the vessel was totally destroyed. On 17th February they were picked up by a Haitian boat and taken to Ragged Island in the Bahamas.

With the exception of REYES, all the Cubans named on Enclosure II wish to go to Miami. REYES wishes to return to his wife and seven children in Cuba but is afraid of reprisals by the Cuban Government. The escapees gave as their reasons for leaving Cuba that the Cuban Government was bad and was causing starvation, and one man said he left because of "starvation and Communism". He had previously served with CASTRO's army as a radio technician.

The above information and notes have been forwarded by our office in Jamaica as of possible interest to you in view of the fact that a number of these Cubans wish to come to the United States.

His passport shows his occupation as "businessman" but he states that if he had not put himself down as a "conserje" he would not have obtained a passport. He says that Gustavo HERRERA, a refugee Cuban now working in a garage at 26th Street, Miami can vouch for him.
