Piore Fedeli, a Swiss national who recently arrived in Mexico from Cuba where he had resided for eleven years, furnished the following information on July 25, 1962.

Fedeli stated he had initially supported the Castro regime because he thought that Castro really intended to correct some of the defects of the previous Cuban regimes. Subsequent events proved that he was wrong, and he became active in a Cuban rebel group known as 30th of November.

Fedeli and members of his group in Havana, Cuba, for the past six months have been compiling a written and photographic record concerning the present situation in Cuba. Some of the material has been mailed to an individual in Mexico City, but additional material, including the photographs, is still in Havana where efforts are being made to get it out of Cuba. Fedeli was ordered to Mexico to handle the material and to prepare it for publication. According to Fedeli, the material will then be offered to some publication, such as "Life" magazine, for publication for the purpose of raising funds to aid the Cuban rebels.

Fedeli has also been instructed to explore the possibility of organizing a 30th of November group in Mexico. He stated, however, that his initial contacts with Cuban refugees in Mexico have not been very encouraging and he may not be able to locate the individuals he needs.

According to Fedeli, rebel groups in Cuba receive assistance and cooperation from the [Italian, Spanish, Uruguayan] and possibly the [Japanese Embassies]. It is his understanding that members of the [Italian Embassy] have made a profit from this assistance in the past, but that the other [embassies] apparently offer their cooperation without any desire for profit. The operations of the rebels in Cuba at this time are, or necessarily, rather limited since they lack the necessary material support.
