worked on the state investigations for the Texas Legislature's Investigating Committee at Amarillo, Texas, and then at Beaumont and Port Arthur, Texas, which hearings were made during the first week of January, 1961, at Beaumont, Texas. STONE advised he believes BOYKIN was in the Gregg County area for the real purpose of collecting evidence concerning prostitution in Gregg County. STONE advised the only prostitution that is running wide open in the area now is the Mission Courts which are located on Highway No. 80 about three miles east of Longview, Texas.

On February 2, 1961, DL 125 C advised there are no prostitutes operating in Longview, Texas, or in Gregg County, Texas as the Chief of Police had forbidden such activity since December 1959 and the local constables in the Gregg County area have stamped out such activity in the motels and hotels. He stated the only place prostitutes are allowed to run wide open is in the Mission Courts located on Highway No. 80 in Harrison County and that these prostitutes do fill dates in Longview on a call basis. DL 125 C advised he had heard the Harrison County Sheriff's Office, Marshall, Texas, is going to start raiding the Mission Courts and attempt to halt the prostitution at the Mission Courts.
