CUSTODY WERE PART OF GROUP NUMBERING ABOUT FIFTY AMERICAN ADVENTURERS WHO UTILIZED BARRACKS TYPE HOUSE AT ONE SIX FIVE ONE W. FLAGLER ST., MIAMI, WHO WERE ORDERED TO LEAVE PREMISES BY MIAMI PD EARLY PART JAN. SIXTYONE OR FACE ARREST FOR VAGRANCY. ON ONE NINETEEN SIXTYONE, WILLIAM OTIS FULLER, FORMER <sup>F</sup>WALTHY LAND OWNER IN ORIENTE, CUBA, AND ARDENT SUPPORTER OF SUBJECT ADVISED HE HAD NO DIRECT KNOWLEDGE RE ARTICLE OR REPORTED INVASION. HE ADVISED THAT ON THIS DATE THREE AMERICANS, NAMES NOT RECALLED, WHO FORMERLY LIVED ONE SIX FIVE ONE W. FLAGLER ST., MIAMI, AND SUPPORTERS OF MASFERRER VISITED FULLER AT HIS RESIDENCE, MIAMI, THIS DATE, ADVISING HIM THAT AFTER THE MIAMI PD FORCED THE INDIVIDUALS LIVING AT THE FLAGLER STREET ADDRESS TO LEAVE, APPROXIMATELY THREE WEEKS AGO, MANY WENT THEIR SEPARATE WAYS, HOWEVER, SIX REMAINED TOGETHER, PRESUMABLY THOSE LISTED ABOVE. TWO OF THE SIX ARE BELIEVED TO HAVE SOLD THEIR AUTOMOBILES, NOT DESCRIBED, FOR ARMS AND AMMUNITION AND EITHER HIRED OR STOLE A BOAT AT MARATHON KEY. FURTHER DETAILS NOT RECALLED BY FULLER. FULLER ALSO ADVISED MASFERRER AND CEFERINO CAPOTE, CLOSE ASSOCIATE AND SUPPORTER OF SUBJECT. BOTH DENIED DIRECT KNOWLEDGE <sup>OF</sup> ~~OR~~ REPORTED ~~OF~~ OF INVASION. MM FOUR NINE TWO DASH S UNABLE TO FURNISH ADDITIONAL
