ROLANDO ARCADIO MASFERRER ROJAS, NM. REMYTEL AND BUTEL CALL  
 JANUARY TWENTYFIFTH. KENNETH J. PROCTOR AND FOUR OF HIS  
 COMPANIONS, INCLUDING MILFORD GARFIELD LAWSON, THORNTON LEWIS  
 TOWNSEND, ANDREW LEE CAMPBELL, AND KENNETH GIRARD WOODLAND,  
 LOCATED AND INTERVIEWED NIGHT OF JANUARY TWENTYFIFTH. EACH  
 DENIED KNOWLEDGE OF SPECIFIC INVASION PLANS. CLAIMED THEY  
 HAD NO PLAN TO DEPART FOR CUBA IN NEAR FUTURE, PRINCIPALLY  
 BEACUSE THEY ARE UNACCEPTABLE TO ALL ANTI CASTRO GROUPS IN  
 THIS AREA. THEY DENIED THEY HAD ANY PLANS TO OBTAIN BOAT,  
 ARMS OR EQUIPMENT. PROCTOR, HOWEVER, HAD IN HIS POSSESSION

EXPEDITION. PROCTOR DENIED KNOWLEDGE OF SIGNIFICANCE OF
