Enclosed for both the Criminal and the Internal Security Divisions are single copies of a memorandum dated January 28, 1960, which sets forth information concerning a plot by Cuban agents to kidnap Rolando Masferrer, prominent anti-Castro exile, and transport him to Cuba. The subjects involved in this matter were arrested by representatives of our Miami Office on January 27, 1960.

A summary of the enclosed data has been furnished the Vice President and the Attorney General. The information in the enclosed memorandum has been furnished the Department of State, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Immigration and Naturalization Service, and the intelligence branches of the Armed Forces.

For your confidential information, Fernandez has been utilized by our Miami Office since 1955 as a paid source concerning Cuban matters. Since September, 1959, he has been in Cuba and contact with him has been extremely limited. While it is not known at this time whether Fernandez intended to advise us later of this plot or was going through with it without telling us, his arrest as a participant was necessary in view of the manner in which the situation developed.
