NOTE: MM 635-S is a Miami informant who was arrested in a kidnaping-conspiracy case in which Rolando Masferrer, anti-Castro leader, was victim. Informant was released on bond and returned to Cuba. We instructed MM not to direct his activities or make further payments to him until his case was resolved. Reairtel reported that informant on 4/21/60 sent letter to Miami's confidential post office box advising he was working in office of commander general under orders of chief of police in Cuba. He stated he hoped to come to MM to talk to MM Office, but did not have money for trip. Asked if money could be sent to him. On 5/2/60 MM Office directed letter to him in veiled terms stating consideration could not be given to furnishing him money until his case has been resolved. USA, MM, advised case involving informant not yet presented to Federal Grand Jury and USA awaiting Departmental decision concerning questions presented by him concerning prosecution. MM Office suggested Bureau consult Department in effort to expedite his case. Upon receipt of report, it will be furnished Department with request for expeditious reply. MM feels the "technicality" of the informant's being involved in this matter is depriving Bureau of a well-placed and potentially productive source on intelligence activities of the Castro government. Bureau cannot place itself in the position of directing activities of an informant and paying him for info while a pending kidnaping-conspiracy case involving him has not yet been resolved. (u)
