the Latin American Anit-Communist Army. They use these fictitious names for the purpose of confusing federal and local police agencies. (See Miami letter with LHM dated 1/7/75 in this case).

Subsequently MM 3240-S obtained additional information regarding this group from de LEON and through contact with several group members. On 2/13/75, MM 3240-S was recontacted specifically to clarify and supplement information previously furnished on 1/31 and 2/11/75 concerning this matter and the following information was obtained:

(u) Latin American Anti-Communist Group - Puerto Rico

The group of young Cuban activists in Puerto Rico who call themselves the Latin American Anti-Communist Group is not known to have any other name or to be affiliated with any other organization. The group in Puerto Rico is under the leadership of an engineer who provides money and leadership, but stays in the background and whose identity is not freely discussed. According to conversation among members of the group, there are members of the FLNC in Puerto Rico who are members of the Latin American Anti-Communist Group. There are apparently some 21 individuals who are considered to be members of this group in Puerto Rico.

The only known members to this source at this time are as follows:

1. ANTONIO VALLE FRIEND, aka Tony, about 38 years old, 5'10" tall, 185 pounds, brown eyes, dark hair, mustache, resides at Calle 11 J-6, Copey Gardes, Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico. He is married and has a small business.
