During an interview this week with BILL WALRAVEN in connection with telephone calls made to his residence from an individual in Texas, it was learned that Mrs. JEAN WALRAVEN is a close friend of ELEANOR HAILEY, wife of HORACE PERRY HAILEY. According to BILL WALRAVEN, the HAILEYs visited them in the latter part of 1964 and that in December, 1964, HORACE PERRY HAILEY was voluntarily admitted to the Federal Hospital at Lexington, Kentucky to take the "cure". WALRAVEN said he believed HAILEY was scheduled for six months of treatment.

IKE MONROE WINKLE, Jr., AR OC 92-248

A PCI in Clinton, Oklahoma area has advised that WINKLE participated in a dice game at the Calmez Hotel in Clinton on the night of 2/10-11/65. PCI learned at this time that WINKLE had recently seriously beaten an individual from the panhandle area of the state known as "WAYNOKA BOB" (BOB HANNIFIOUS).

Another PCI, who is an associate of WINKLE, advised this week that WINKLE has been "barred" from gambling at Clinton apparently because of WINKLE's use of crooked dice. PCI said WINKLE had attempted to join the VFW Club in Clinton in order to have access to dice games, but that WINKLE's application had been rejected and the initial payment made by WINKLE had been returned to him.
