For the information of the Bureau, NOFIO PECORA has been previously identified as Bufile ~~137-10042~~.

The following is a summary of information provided by NO 1298-C*, during the period from 2/19/62 to 3/1/65:

NO 1298-C*

During captioned period, this informant has developed on a day to day basis, the following general information concerning PECORA, his wife, FRANCES, and his mother-in-law, Mrs. A. D. or A. E. SMITH, and other individuals, significance of which are not as yet known:

During the carnival season, NOFIO and his wife, FRANCES, brought a carnival to New Orleans for the Mardi Gras season. In unsuccessful attempts to get a permit for this carnival to operate, FRANCES contacted Mayor SCHIRO for permission to have the show in the downtown section, but was refused.

Of interest, was that according to informant, FRANCES and NOFIO told the Mayor that the money made on the carnival was to be donated to crippled childrens fund and that they planned on keeping at least 75% of the money
