Dear Mr. Hoover:

In November 1951, an application for admission to Canada was made by one Andrew ~~X~~ SHEN of Chilliwack, B.C. on behalf of one Nicolai ~~X~~ Nikolovich KURGANOFF ~~X~~ KURGANOV. KURGANOFF was born at ~~X~~ Tarnob, Russia on January 22, 1888, but was then residing in Shanghai, China, stateless.

2. This Headquarters was advised on September 27, 1952 that KURGANOFF had been granted the status of a "landed immigrant" in Canada this date. He carried U.S.S.R. Passport, No. 1648/6034 issued by the U.S.S.R. Consulate in Shanghai, on March 7, 1947, which was endorsed with Canadian Immigrant Visa, No. 1167/52, issued by the British Consul General, Shanghai, on May 23, 1952, valid for six months. The U.S.S.R. Passport expired on March 7, 1952.

3. As we have heard that KURGANOFF was refused a U.S. Immigrant Visa in 1953 by the U.S. Government, for alleged Communist connections in the Orient, we would greatly appreciate being provided with as complete an outline as possible on his former activities if these have been brought to your attention.

4. For your information, since KURGANOFF's arrival in Canada, he has been visited on two occasions by a Mr. Peter ~~X~~ GREGORY from Fort Worth, Texas, who is reported to be a fairly wealthy Consulting Engineer at that point. GREGORY is reported to have known KURGANOFF in the far East and is alleged to be a close friend. The reliability of this source, from whom this information was obtained, has not been assessed, and is merely forwarded to you as it may have some possible significance.

5. From another source considered reliable, it has been learned that members of the local Russian Orthodox Congregation in Vancouver, B.C., who have had conversations with KURGANOFF, regard him as being a Communist sympathizer due to the pro-Soviet statements which he has made. There is, however, nothing on record at this Headquarters to indicate that KURGANOFF is engaged in subversive activity or has formed affiliations with any of the local Communist or "front" organizations in Vancouver and district up to the present date.


