On 8/24/61 Dr. Aristide Manopulo, Central Bureau, Italian Criminal Police, Rome, Italy, was contacted and apprised of subjects' alleged activities in Italy. Dr. Manopulo was requested to advise of any indication subjects have been in Italy, as well as to furnish any information which has come to his attention concerning these individuals. (u)

Vertical stamp or mark on right margin

On 8/25/61 Dr. Manopulo advised that no information identifiable with the subjects has come to his attention. He further stated that all checks made in Rome, Italy, failed to indicate either Zaintraub or Tourine, aka Charlie White, had been in Rome recently. He stated, however, that during 1958 one Charles Tourine del Monaco, born May 20, 1927, in Hawawan, New Jersey, wrote to Italian Criminal Police, Rome, Italy, advising he was trying to locate his father, Charles Tourine. At this time the writer of the letter furnished his address as 120 Central Park South, New York City. He further related that his father, Charles Tourine, held U. S. passport No. 275403 issued January 28, 1957. (u)

Check of records of Tourist Bureau, Italian Police, Rome, Italy, made on 8/25/61, failed to reveal any information indicating Charles Tourine, Charlie White, or Anissin George Zaintraub had recently resided in Rome. Tourist Bureau maintains records of guests lodging in hotels and pensions in Italy. (u)

It is noted re London cable requests Bureau to advise whether subjects wanted. UACB no further action being taken by Rome Office in this matter. (u)
