

Pullman holds Canadian Passport No. 4.422213 which is valid until May 12, 1964. He is the son of Benjamin and Rosemarie Richard, and is related to Joan Arlene Richardson, who was born November 15, 1935, at Toronto, Canada. According to Swiss authorities, Pullman resided at the Beau-Rivage Hotel, Lausanne, Switzerland, following his arrival on September 25, 1960, and on December 27, 1960, he moved to an apartment at 20 Avenue de Valmont, which has been previously mentioned. In registering with Swiss authorities as a foreigner, he mentioned that he had previously resided at 54 Road Avenue, Toronto, Canada, and indicated that he was a retired businessman who had sufficient funds in order to live without working.

The Swiss Central Police Bureau advised that Tourine and Langley are unknown to Swiss authorities, as is Armand Cerant, whom Tourine telephoned from Clarens on August 12. Pullman has not been questioned by Swiss authorities concerning his relationship with subject or George Langley.
