The Police Judiciaire (Criminal Police) of the Sûreté Nationale (PJSN) advised by letter dated 12/22/6,2 that the individual previously referred to as ARMAND CERANT is identified as ARMAND DIAZ SERAMI, born 2/22/20 at Hackensack, New Jersey. This individual was probably in contact with CHARLES TOURINE. A record was found at the Hotel Plaza Athenée, Paris, indicating that CERAMI stayed there from May 29 to June 7, 1962, and again from August 11 to August 13, 1962, accompanied by his wife, DONNA LEA CERAMI, who was born 4/15/25 in Missouri. The residence given by this couple was 6437 North Bay Road, Miami Beach, Florida. ARMAND CERAMI was in possession of \overline{U}_{\circ} S. passport 1512897 issued 6/2/59 at Miami, and his wife was in possession of U.S. passport 2469436, issued 10/21/60 at Miami. The reservations for CERAMI and his wife had been arranged by the Fugazy Travel Agency of New York City. CERAMI and his wife were previously unknown in the files of the French police.
