ADMINISTRATIVE:

During the course of contact with NK 2603-C-TE on 9/29/67, informant commented that he was not surprised to hear that JOE CASEY and JAMES JULIANO came to a violent end. Informant said that CASEY was always outspoken and inclined to create trouble. He said that he knew CASEY for 30 to 40 years and recalls a number of instances in CASEY's past, one in particular, he related, involved JOE CASEY's first wife, RENE. Informant related that this took place about 1935 when CASEY got word that "LITTLE PUSSY" RUSSO and "GYP" DE CARLO were seeking to make time with CASEY's wife. Informant said that CASEY put on two guns and started looking for RUSSO and DE CARLO and would perhaps have carried out his stated intention.

Informant said that he has no particular knowledge of CASEY's killer but would be alert for any information he might receive concerning this matter. He commented that he feels it would not be logical that RICHIE BOIARDO would have anything to do with it because if he were so inclined, he would have had CASEY killed at the time CASEY left him on the street following an unsuccessful effort to kill RICHIE BOIARDO many years ago.

Periodic spot checks conducted at subject's residence and know hangouts in the New York City area were conducted during the investigative period by SAS CHARLES G. DONNELLY, PAUL G. DURKIN and EUGENE F. FITZPATRICK.
