On 7/11/63, WF 1108-C advised SA JOHN R. BUCHLEY that the subject had been spending a substantial amount of time at his residence, 1903 Chillum Road, Avondale, Maryland, during the previous two weeks. Informant said that GEORGE ROMANINA was a frequent visitor to the NESLINE residence during that period.

Informant advised that NESLINE planned to attend the Harbore Race Track during the current meeting and that NESLINE would probably accept wagers from the numerous gamblers and bookies that would be in daily attendance at that track. Informant said that although NESLINE has been to race tracks frequently during the past few months (Dosecroft and Laurel Raceways) that he ~~may~~<sup>SELDOM</sup> have bets on the races. He said that NESLINE would book wagers on the outcome of races provided that the bettors put up the necessary cash.

On 7/17/68, WF 1108-C advised SA BUCKLEY that NESLINE had been living in the District of Columbia for the previous few days. He said that NESLINE wanted to avoid harassment by Maryland law enforcement officials and constant visits and calls from members of the area gambling fraternity.

On 7/22/68, informant advised that NESLINE was at his home, Avondale, Maryland, on the weekend of 7/21/68.

On 7/25/68, WF 1108-C advised that he had learned that NESLINE had been staying with CHARLES TOURINE at the Appolline Apartments, 1380 New Hampshire Avenue, N. W., on an intermittent basis for the past two weeks. Informant said that he knew of no reason why NESLINE would remain away from his residence, Avondale, Maryland, other than that set out above. He said that he knew of no gambling activity that NESLINE and TOURINE were conducting at the present time.

WFO will follow the activities of NESLINE and TOURINE closely and will advise the Bureau and Baltimore of significant developments.
