Re Baltimore airtel to the Director dated 3/19/64, copies of which was designated for Miami.

FRANK B. MARTIN and RICHARD SMITH, mentioned on page 3 of re airtel, are the subjects of a current investigation of the Baltimore Office entitled FRANK BUHLER MARTIN, aka; RICHARD I. SMITH, aka, ITAR-GAMBLING (Bufile 166-783, Miami file 166-170, BA file 166-102) in which Miami has current leads.

On 2/1/64 MARTIN who was visiting Miami, Florida suffered a heart attack and was hospitalized at Mt. Sinai Hospital, Miami, Fla. By airtel dated 3/11/64 Miami advised on 3/3/64 Dr. HOWARD GRUMER, Miami Beach, advised that MARTIN had been released over the past weekend from the hospital and was currently convalescing. Dr. GRUMER stated that MARTIN would be incapacitated and under medical supervision for many weeks.

According to confidential informants SMITH was handling MARTIN's lay-off operation in the Washington, D.C. area while the latter was recuperating in Florida, however, on 2/22/64 RH 95-C-TE advised that JOE NESLINE on that date reportedly stated that he disliked the way SMITH was handling MARTIN's work and that he would make the collections for MARTIN himself.
