INFORMANTS

Denver T-1 is DN-100-c, whose identity is known to the Bureau. Chicago T-2 is JOSEPH G. COLOSIMO, U. S. Probation Officer, Chicago, Illinois, who furnished information to Chicago Agents on a confidential basis and who stated that information he was reporting was gained in a personal conversation between himself and JAMES HENRY DOLAN on June 9, 1952.

At Chicago, Illinois

At Hanley and Company will attempt to secure photographic copies of time cards reflecting BYRNES' absence from work from June 4, to 8th, 1951, and from July 9 to 13, 1951, and forward same to Denver. Will determine identity of Hanley and Company official who is competent to testify in this matter and present in evidence original time card records.

Will locate and interview JAMES HENRY DOLAN concerning this matter as soon as possible as requested in Denver report dated May 12, 1953.

Will conduct appropriate investigation seeking to establish evidence that JAMES HENRY DOLAN and LAWRENCE FRANCIS BYRNES are acquainted with each other; the extent of their association, and if possible whether they were associating with each other either in Chicago or elsewhere during the summer of 1951.

Will seek to locate additional known specimens of the signature of LAWRENCE FRANCIS BYRNES and forward same to the FBI Laboratory for further examination.

Will locate and interview JOEY GOODMAN, Los Angeles PD #85029, and interview him as requested in Denver letter of June 3, 1953.
