On September 25, 1959, SA JAMES E. GILLEY displayed a photograph of SAMUEL MANNARINO to CV 380-C and CV 438-C. Both stated that MANNARINO was unfamiliar to them. Informants were also questioned concerning the possible implication of PAT FERRUCCIO, local Canton hoodlum, being involved in the Canton Armory theft. Both informants indicated that, to their knowledge, FERRUCCIO was not implicated in the theft. They stated that FERRUCCIO is a gambler but he has not been known to engage in any burglaries or robberies of any type.
