Re Latent Fingerprint Section, Bureau Identification letter to Miami dated 10/16/74, advising that fingerprints of 21 listed potential suspects are not identical to latents developed on several UMA letters in this case.

MM 1550-KS and MM 1337-S, who have furnished information previously concerning UMA have advised that UMA has been dormant and no additional UMA letters have been received or reported.

On November 21, 1974, MARIETA FANDINO, editor of "La Verdad", Miami, advised that an anonymous Cuban male had telephoned her to state that UMA is being dissolved. MARIETA FANDINO has been regarded as a potential suspect.

On September 16, 1974, Assistant U. S. Attorney GRAFTON WILSON advised that he did not think a violation of the Federal Extortion Statute existed and said that he would decline prosecution. On this basis the extortion case on UMA was closed out.

This case is being placed in a closed status subject to being reopened in the event future developments so justify.
