ReBulet instructed New York to institute investigation  
concerning OSCAR MIGUEL NODARSE.

Enclosed herewith for the Bureau are 9 copies of an  
LHM setting forth information resulting from an interview of  
NODARSE. Information copies are being furnished to Miami and  
San Juan. *d*

A copy of the enclosed LHM is being disseminated locally  
to INS, NYC.

NY T-1, mentioned in enclosed LHM, is JOSE MARCOS  
CABEZON FEITO, who furnished information to the San Juan  
Office on 11/12/68.

NODARSE, during interview, was cooperative and  
offered his assistance to the Bureau. The NYO has received  
word from other sources that NODARSE has been telling several  
Cubans of his contact by the FBI and also related the questions  
which were asked and inquiries about individual Cubans and  
organizations. In view of above and also due to fact that  
NODARSE is not trusted by other Cubans, the NYO will make  
no effort to develop him as a PSI.
