It has been brought to the attention of the San Juan Office in the recent past that various local agencies, U.S. Coast Guard, in particular, have a direct interest in the Comandos L. Vessel named the "Angelina". This interest stems from the fact that the Coast Guard believes that this vessel is about to engage in some sort of attack on either Cuba or Haiti. Consequently, the capabilities of the "Angelina" are being set forth in this LHM and it is suggested that as wide a range as possible be given in dissemination.

ADMINISTRATIVE

The confidential source mentioned in the LHM is PSI (UD) JULIO BRAVO, the present registered owner of the "Angelina". (u)

It is to be noted that if the "Angelina" does depart from Puerto Rico, BRAVO will most likely not sail with the vessel. (u)
